Kiehl was born on July 7, 1940 and lived most of her life in Central FL. She grew up in the College Park area of Orlando and attended Princeton Elem., Memorial Jr. High and graduated from Edgewater High School in 1958. She attended Grady Memorial Hospital School of Nursing graduating in 1961. She also graduated from St. Leo College Magna Cum Laude in 1980 with a B.A. in Psychology.

Most of Carol's nursing career was in the Orlando area at Orange Memorial, Holiday and Lucerne General Hospitals. Carol's most rewarding work was the 20 years she worked as an Emergency Room Nurse. After moving to Wildwood she did home health until her retirement in 2006.

Carol is a member of the First Baptist Church of Wildwood and participated in several Mission trips, baking for Wednesday Night Suppers, Prayer Room Ministry, Choir and helping out as she could to serve the Lord.

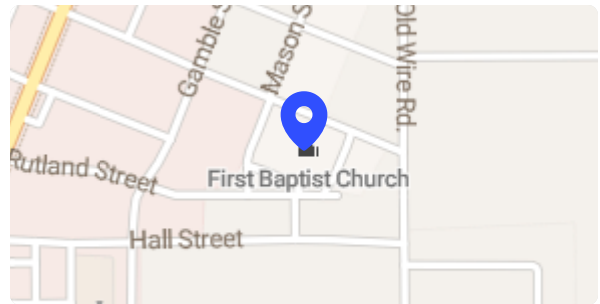

If desired, In lieu of flowers, donations can be made to First Baptist Church of Wildwood – Transportation Fund or Sumter County Humane Society.






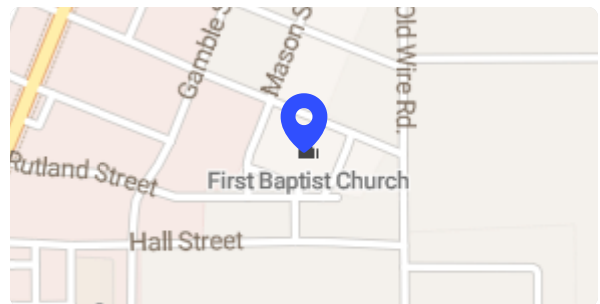

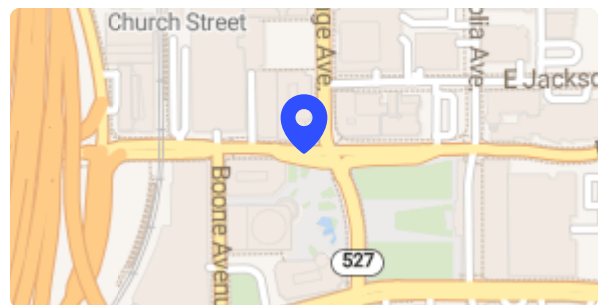

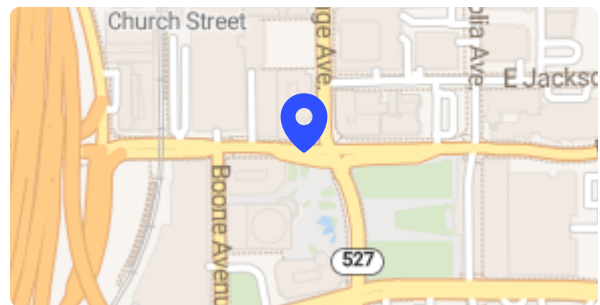
