Carl E Wilson Jr. passed away Wednesday September 8th, 2015 at the age of 69 surrounded by his family and friends. He was born May 25, 1946 in Louisville Kentucky. Carl married his high school sweet heart and love of his life Joanne (Dawson) Wilson on October 2nd, 1965 . They were married for 49 loving years with less than one month away from celebrating 50 years of marriage at the time of his passing.

Carl graduated from Toms River High School in 1964 where he was actively involved in school sports playing football where he was a team captain. He served our country in the United States Marine Corps during the Vietnam War. He also was a member of the Air National Guard serving a total of 23 years in the United States Military. 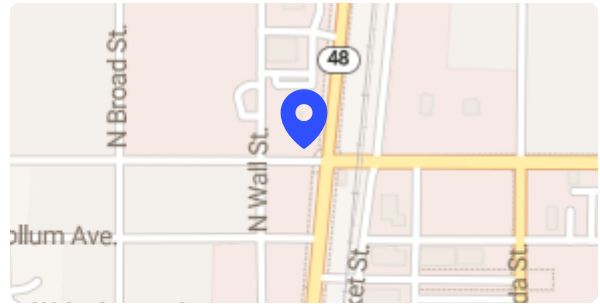

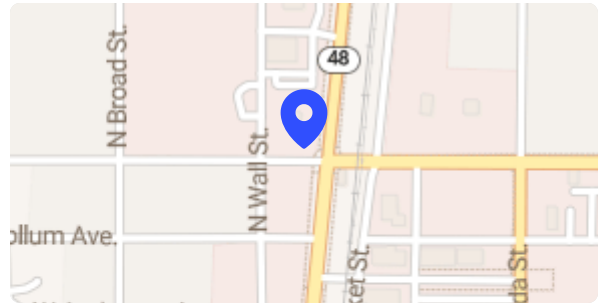
