After World War II, she married Ceasar in 1946 and celebrated their 69th wedding anniversary July 27, 2015. They had two children, Janet Claire (Merop) and Daniel Turchiarelli, Sr., five grandchildren, and two great-grandchildren and another on the way.

Tessie was a lively, spirited person who was always on the go. She was the heart of her home and loved being hospitable, especially around her table serving delicious meals and engaging in fellowship with family and friends. 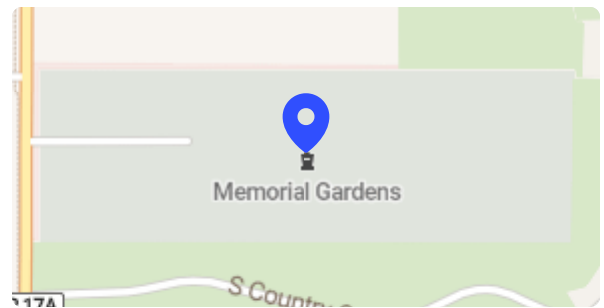

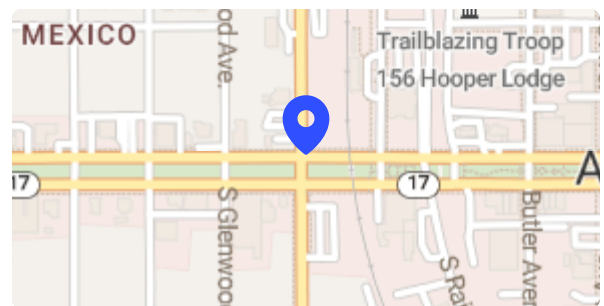
