# **Glen Ray Elfrank**

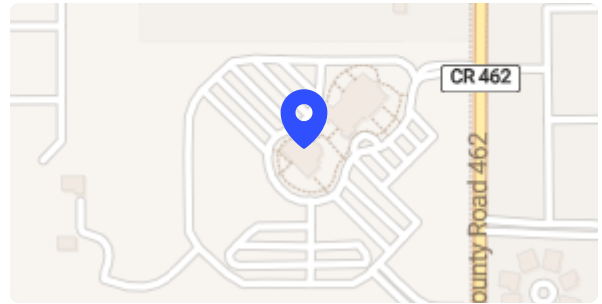

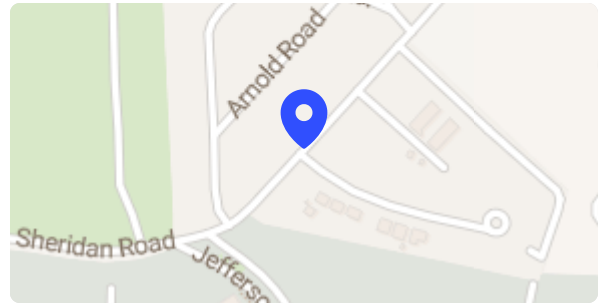
