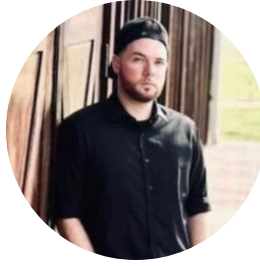

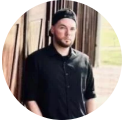
He has many, many friends who love him dearly along with his faithful dog, Moose.

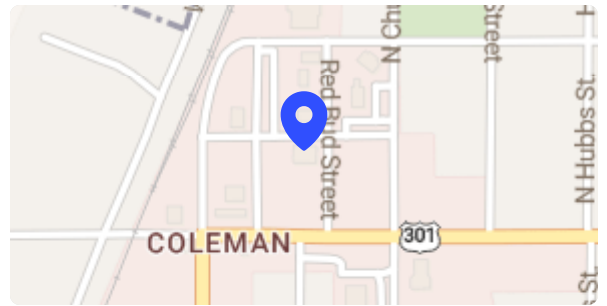

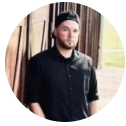
