Martin Snader, 95, passed away December 4, 2024 under the care of Hospice of Marion County at The Ted & Diane Brandley Hospice House surrounded by his loving family. Martin was born on August 18, 1929 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania to parents Charles Snader and Bessie (Kratchman) Snader.

He was a Graphic Designer in the Corporate Advertising Industry and was the owner of Martin Snader Lettering and Art. Martin was of the Jewish faith and was a Member of Congregation Beth Sholom of Leesburg, Florida. A Member of B'rith Shalom in New Jersey. A Member of The Jewish Community Center of Cherry Hill, NJ and was a Member of the Philadelphia Art Guild. Martin was a proud United States Army Veteran serving in the occupation of Germany after World War II.

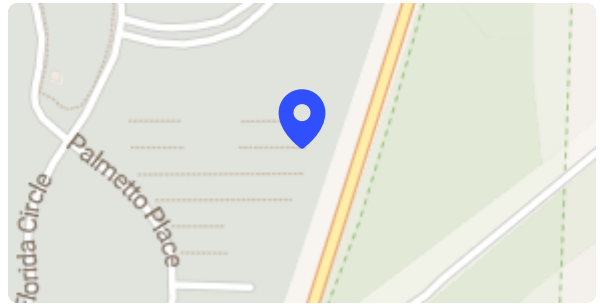

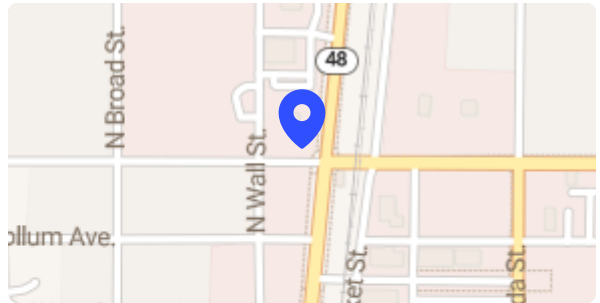
