Edwin Paul Boxler, 83, Wildwood, Florida went to be with his Lord and Savior on June 2, 2025 at UF Health Spanish Plainses Hospital in The Villages, Florida. Ed was born November 29, 1941 in Akron, Ohio to his parents Edwin Charles Boxler and Mary Jay (Ross) Boxler.

Ed graduated from East High School in Akron, Ohio. He was a Vietnam Veteran who served in the United States Army. Ed then joined the Akron Ohio Police Department for 24 years serving as a Motorcycle Officer and then retiring as a Detective. He then worked as a criminal investigator for the First Merit Bank until retiring again. He was a member of the Fraternal Order of Eagles of Beverly, Ohio. Ed and his wife Gail moved to Wildwood, Florida in 1997 from Akron, Ohio. He was a member of First Baptist Church of Leesburg, Florida, where he served as a Deacon. Ed enjoyed golfing, fishing hunting and the sunshine of Florida.

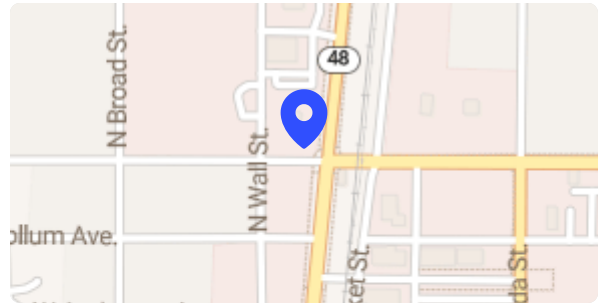
