Wynne Edith Wynne (Cannon) Greene, 64, of Wildwood, FL was called home to be with her Lord and Savior, Jesus on Saturday, June 7, 2025 at Lane Purcell Hospice house in Sumterville, with her brother and sister at her bedside.

Wynne was born on April 26, 1961 to W. D. and Betty (Waldron) Cannon in Jacksonville, Florida. The family moved to Wildwood in 1970 where she lived for the rest of her life. She graduated from Wildwood High School in 1979 and then attended Lake-Sumter Community College.

Wynne is survived by her sister, Cheryl McKinney, brother, Milton (Krissy) Cannon, her nephew, Joshua (Barbra)McKinney, niece Caitlin (Andrew) Eaton, and nephew, Chandler Cannon. 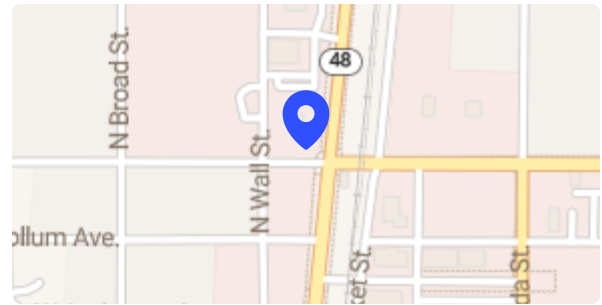

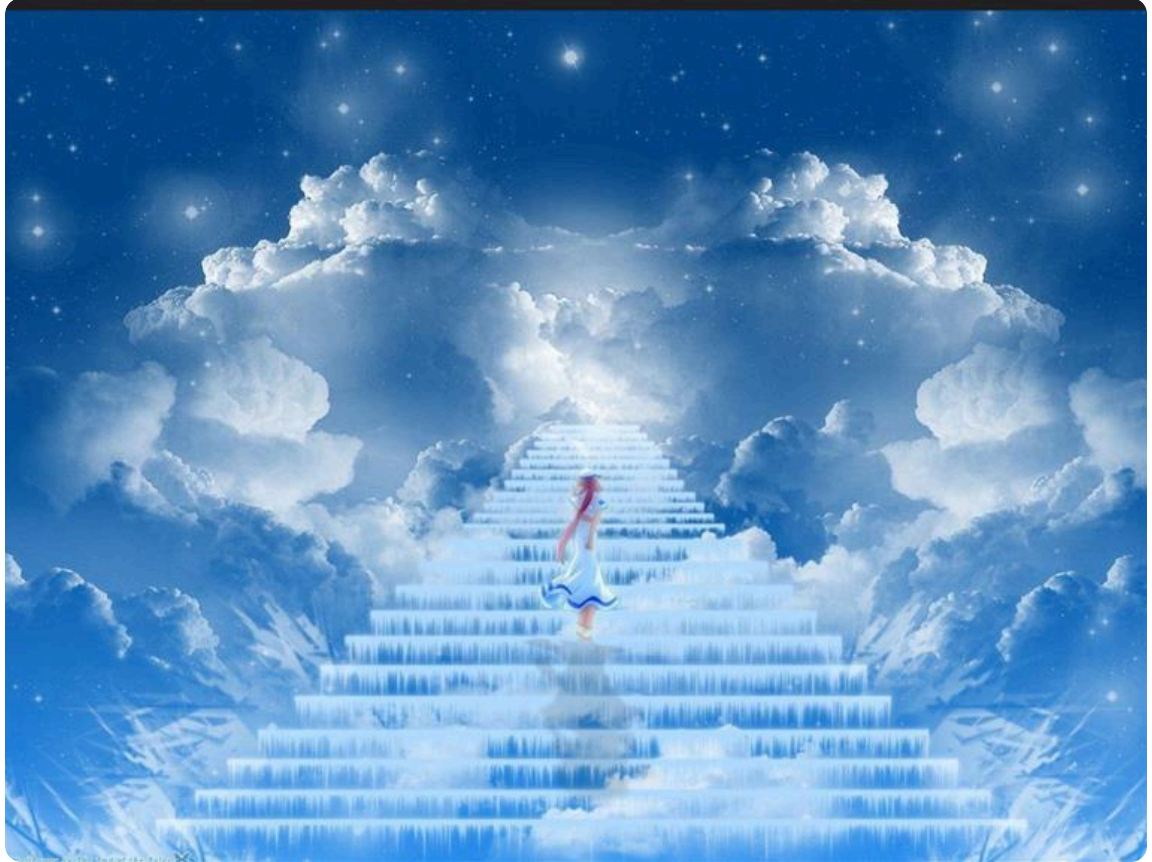
