We weren't as close in recent years—we had drifted apart. Many who knew him, knew that he faced some tough battles in his life, and though we had our distance, I never stopped hoping we'd reconnect. I believed there would be time to rebuild. Recently, he had been turning things around, and I was genuinely proud of the progress he was making. He gave his life to the Lord as a teenager, and I hold on to the peace of knowing he's with Jesus now. I'm grieving not only the loss of his life, but also the loss of what could have been. The driver who took his life also took away the chance for healing and new memories. Still, I pray for her. I pray she finds peace, and that her family is surrounded with comfort. I pray she can forgive herself and I pray that she surrenders her life to Jesus. He is the only way. Quentin and I loved Dale dearly. Colton and Kenzie loved him so much—we always talked about him and shared stories and laughs from the past. Now, those memories are all we have left, and we'll cherish them forever. This is just another heartbreaking reminder of why drinking and driving is never worth it. One decision can change countless lives forever. Also a word of advice—if there's someone in your life you've been meaning to reconnect with, don't wait. Reach out. You never know how much time you have with the people you love.
